

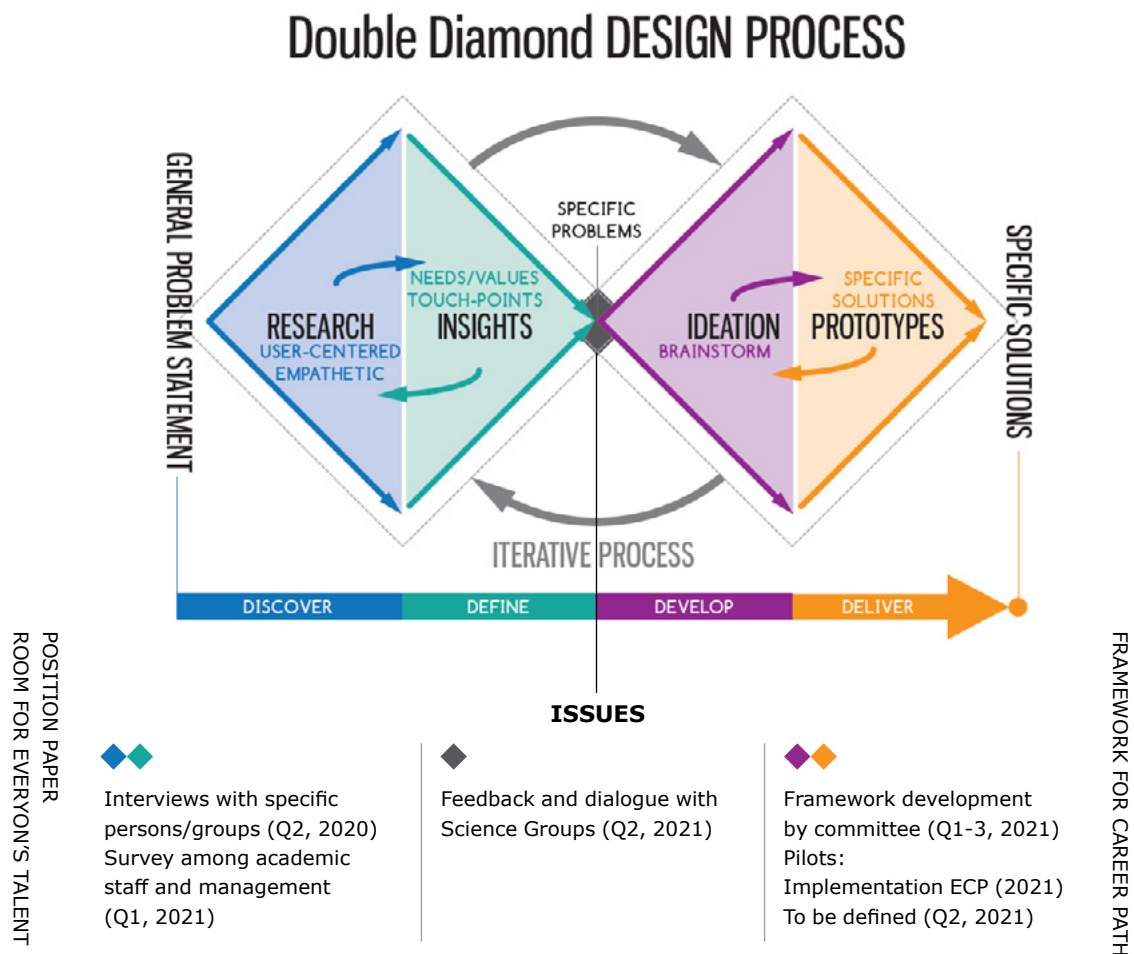
# Recognition & Rewards at Wageningen University & Research
