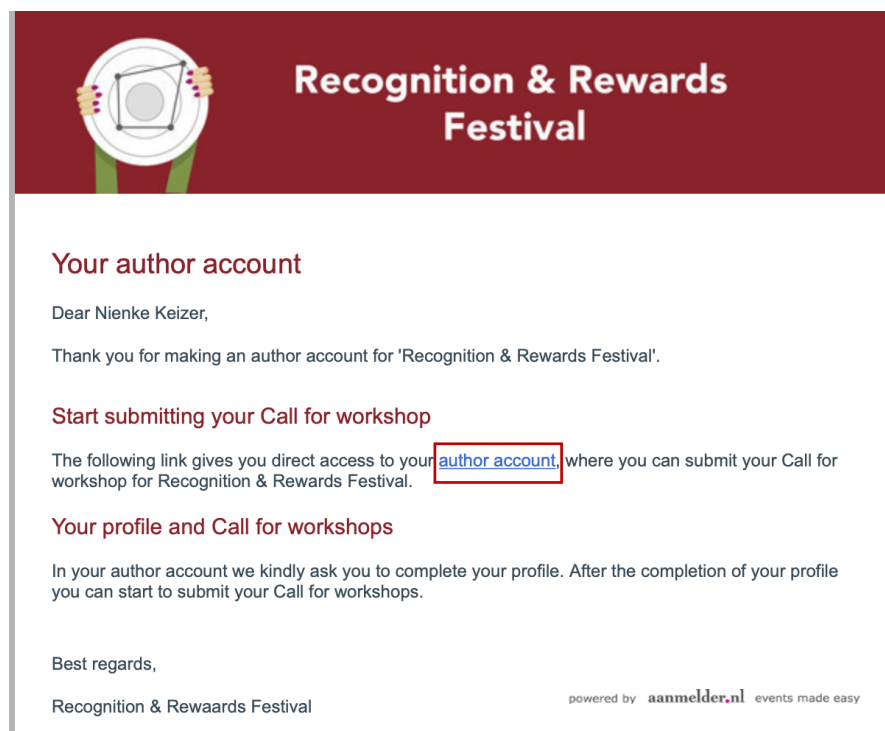

Call for workshops Recognition & Rewards Festival

The third edition of the Recognition & Rewards Festival will take place on the 13th of April, 2023. We will discuss the opportunities, challenges and dilemmas of culture and system change. Additionally, we would like to offer several on site workshops focusing on specific elements of recognising and rewarding academics differently. This year the Recognition & Rewards Festival has a special focus on Rethinking Assessment. On which basis will we assess research, teaching, teamwork and so on? How do we ensure the quality of assessment? And how do assessment and development relate to each other? There is a big international movement regarding Reforming Research Assessment. But what are the main developments in the other domains in academia? These questions and many more topics will be discussed during the Recognition & Rewards Festival.

The festival will kick off with a plenary session in which we share insights, experiences, and examples from the past year. We will take a moment to reflect on our achievements and discuss what still lies ahead. The Festival will then continue with a focus on the theme of this years Recognition & Rewards Festival. We will then split up into groups in which participants can discuss these subjects in more depth. There will be two rounds of onsite workshops. With this call we invite you to send in a workshop proposal.

The festival is organised by the Recognition & Rewards Programme, a partnership between the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW), the Netherlands Federation of University Medical Centres (NFU), the Dutch Denominational Universities (NLU), the Dutch Research Council (NWO), Universities of The Netherlands (UNL) and the Netherlands Organisation for Health Research and Development (ZonMw) with funding and support from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Science.

Practical information

- The workshop lasts 60-75 minutes
- Group size of approximately 25 people
- The workshop has an interactive character. We find it especially important that there is room for the perspective of every participant.
- Language is English
- The workshop takes place physically at the festival location
- The festival location is probably in Utrecht
- The exact time of the workshop has yet to be determined. We ask everyone to make a reservation in advance from 09.00 – 17.00 in the agenda.
